Our goal is to ensure that every child has the opportunity to hear and communicate effectively, enhancing their quality of life and future opportunities. We are committed to providing the best care possible.












FROM DOUBTER TO BELIEVER!

POST-CPR STATUS: GOING HOME

A preterm baby delivered at Panchtar Hospital received CPR during delivery and again at our hospital's ER. The baby stayed on a ventilator for 4 days. The post-extubation course was complicated by a complete collapse of the right lung and other issues. The NICU team never gave up hope (bronchoscopy was not possible according to the pediatric intensivist) and improvised the management. Finally, the baby is going home today after a 22-day hospital stay. Neurologically, the baby is fine.



P.S. The child received 100% free treatment under the Koshi scheme.
