







CHART OF 2080 BAISHAKH TO 2081ASHAR INPATIENT

ROMI RAI'S JOURNEY: GOING HOME AFTER A NEAR-DEATH EXPERIENCE

Romi Rai, a 17-year-old female from Letang, was initially s treated for neurologic symptoms locally. Even after spending almost 40K in one day and facing financial issues, her outcome looked poor. presented to KDCH with seizures and hospital stay was treated for multitude of serious medical issues but with the excellent PICU care at KDCH, she improved progressively and got discharged with no residual illness.



RETURNING HOME (LESS THAN 10% SURVIVAL DURING ADMISSION)

Krishang Tamang from Illam arrived at KDCH for treatment after already spending a lot. He presented in refractory status epilepticus. The child was managed as a pediatric stroke case. Thanks to the medical team for stabilizing him and the PICU team for the rehabilitation process. He was discharged after a 2week stay. The child smiled during photography, but his mouth was deviated due to facial palsy, which is improving. Treatment was done for free under Koshi scheme.

In our monthly newsletters, we provide updates on the construction progress of KIOCH-Kathmandu Children's Hospital, highlighting milestones achieved and significant strides made.


