




WHAT MAKES A PEDIATRICIAN GRATIFY?

When a neonate passes urine or stool, and especially when an extremely preterm neonate is discharged from the NICU, it's a moment of triumph. One of the biggest milestones for our hospital is the story of Yamuna Upreti, born at 27 weeks and weighing just 26 ounces (750 grams). She was brought to our NICU, where she earned the nickname "fighter" from our doctors. After facing all the challenges of being preterm, she was successfully discharged after nearly 1.5 months—the longest stay in our NICU so far. She gained more than satisfactory weight and discharged after making parents confident. Kudos to the entire NICU team!





STORY OF ISAKINA RAI

A 7-year-old girl from Taplejung named Isakina Rai was admitted to our hospital in a moribund state. She was treated in the PICU for scrub typhus, myocarditis, and catecholamine-sensitive cardiogenic shock. After a 12-day stay with us, she was discharged in good condition. Follow-up videos show her smiling and in good spirits.
