

KIOCH Call for Fellowship Application



Kathmandu Institute of Child Health (KIOCH) is a registered not for profit organization working towards building a comprehensive pediatric care facility within Nepal. Based on a hub and spoke model, head quarter is based at the Budhanilkantha Municipality, Kathmandu, with a further six satellite centers to be strategically developed in each province of Nepal. Through these efforts, we hope to touch the lives of hundreds of thousands of children in Nepal.

While the factors contributing to high rates of child morbidity and mortality are manifold, KIOCH aims to approach the problem systematically and comprehensively. Our objective is to deliver high quality and affordable care to children across Nepal within a critical time frame. The specific objectives of KIOCH are; to establish and run a multi-specialty children's hospital with satellite services, to help strengthen the referral system, to act as resource center and also provide training in the area of child health, to conduct research studies in the area of child health, to conduct preventive interventions, promotive and rehabilitative services. KIOCH is currently working on building physical infrastructures and building a team of future medical leaders for KIOCH.

KIOCH-Fellowship Program:

The KIOCH has secured some fellowship offers from some of the internationally recognized institutions abroad in which KIOCH can nominate Nepalese doctors for pediatric sub-specialty training. The fellowship program is a part of human resource development policy of KIOCH. KIOCH will nominate one Nepalese doctor meeting the eligibility criteria and willing to work for KIOCH under the terms and conditions as per contract. Awarded fellows will need to sign an agreement with KIOCH agreeing to serve at KIOCH for not less than 3 years after the training.



What the Fellowship Covers?

The fellowship program is an excellent opportunity to get subspeciality training in one of the renowned medical institution in Israel accompanied by the following financial coverage:

- Roundtrip airfare to Israel (one time).
- Waived tuition fee
- A monthly stipend of approximately \$1000 USD (3500 Israel Shekel)
- Selected candidates are responsible for obtaining and paying for their visa.
 Selected candidate is expected to pay a) International Insurance (health/travel) as required by host country, b) Miscellaneous fees and expenses (if any) arising during the course.

Eligibility

All Nepalese medical graduates meeting the following criteria and interested to develop a career on pediatric cardiology are eligible to apply.

- a) Nepal Medical Council (NMC) registered physician with MD-Pediatrics or equivalent degree
- b) Age: not exceeding 45 years at the time of application
- c) Be available to start your fellowship in Israel during 2020

Selection Process

A review panel at KIOCH will create a shortlist of applicants on the basis of documents submitted by the applicant. Shortlisted applicants will be interviewed by KIOCH review panel for the final selection. Selected fellows will be required to certify that they are not already in any kind of bond/agreement with any other institution.



How to Apply

Interested and eligible candidates can send their application through the email: kiochfellowhips@gmail.com no later than 30 December 2019. KIOCH will not accept any applications that are not submitted by the due date. Your application email must include the following supporting documents in order for your application to be eligible for consideration:

- 1. A cover letter explaining what do you expect from the fellowship and after fellowship
- 2. A recently updated CV
- 3. Copy of your citizenship and valid passport
- 4. Copy of your NMC registration
- 5. Copies of transcripts and certificates of your degrees
- 6. Academic reference from the faculties of your highest degree
